

PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR DENTIST AND STAFF

- Review the **SURGICAL TECHNIQUE GUIDE** which can be printed from the pdf. file found at the bottom of the Professionals Page on our website – www.simplysecuredentures.com
- Write or call in the following Prescriptions at least one day prior to procedure. (unless contraindicated). If you have a regimen which you prefer, please feel free to use it. The idea is to provide 8-10 days' antibiotic coverage and adequate postoperative pain relief. The following are merely suggestions:

* Amoxicillin (500 mg), #30, Take 1 every 8 hours starting 1 day prior to procedure. Finish all. No refills.

Penicillin Allergic: Clindamycin (150 mg), #40, Take 1 every 6 hours starting 1 day prior to procedure. Finish all. No refills.

* Vicodin or Vicodin ES, #16, Take 1 every 4-6 hours with 2 Advil as needed for pain. (unless aspirin allergic). 1 Refill.

* Any necessary premedications: Sedation – use your standard regimen. SBE prophylaxis – Have patient start with appropriate prophylaxis dose, and then continue with remainder of Rx for 8-10 days.
